

Case Study – Harlow, Post Office

Project Details:

Working through our client Etec Contract Services, we were asked to carry out the installation of air conditioning & ventilation services to the new refurbished post office in Harlow. Working closely with Etec and the design consultants an installation programme was put together to allow the post office to operate during the day time whilst all the installation took place during the night, the post office had to be spotless every morning to allow customers to come in by 10am

System Description:

A Daikin twin pipe VRV system was installed to allow for heating and cooling to the customer area and back of house office areas, complimenting the VRV system was two Daikin heat recovery ventilation units that allowed fresh air from outside to enter the building, whilst removing stale air to outside, during operation the Daikin ventilation system would transfer upto 80% of the heat from the stale air going out into the cold air coming in, therefore creating huge savings in energy costs.
